What's happening in **WASTE MANAGEMENT**

From 1 July 2021, all collection of household waste will be managed entirely in-house by Teknik- och fritidsförvaltningen Säffle-Åmål.

During the year 2022, the transition will begin to also collect sorted food waste from households in Säffle and Åmål municipalities. The collection will be done using an additional bin, which is ventilated, and paper sacks.

6 QUICK FACTS ABOUT **WASTE COLLECTION**

This is what the municipality does for you

- Ensures your household waste is collected and taken care of.
- Informs about waste collection and recycling.
- Works to create the conditions for sustainable waste management in your municipality.

Waste collection collective & charges

- All properties where household waste may occur are part of the waste collection collective.
- Garden waste, large waste items and hazardous waste are left by households at the recycling centre Östby Environment Station.
- The waste collection charge consists of two parts - a basic charge and a collection charge.

Where to find your **RECYCLING STATIONS**

At the recycling stations you can leave your packaging and newspapers. It is the company Förpacknings- och tidningsinsamlingen (FTI AB) that is responsible for these stations.

If you want to tell them you need cleaning or emptying of containers, you can call their customer service on 0200-88 03 11 or report via the website www.ftiab.se

Tips when you have **EXTRA WASTE!**

- You can order an extra emptying of your bin by calling our customer service.
- Order an extra red sack through customer service or via e-services. The bag is charged on your next invoice.

The sack may weigh a maximum of 15 kg and is placed next to your bin on the normal collection day.

Good to know before **SLUDGE DISCHARGE**

- Mark out the installation and make sure the lid is not covered.
- Keep the area around and up to the installation free of bushes and other vegetation.
- Make sure that the road is driveable for the sludge vehicle, that the width of the road is at least 3.5 meter and there is a free height of at least 4 meter.
- Clear away brushwood and other vegetation along the way, which might otherwise damage the sludge vehicle.
- Clear away snow and lay sand up to your installation if it is emptied in winter.

Good to know before WASTE COLLECTION

- Place the bin clearly visible at your collection point no later than 06:00 on collection day.
- Place your bin within 6 meter of where the garbage truck can stop (Säffle municipality).
- Place your bin within 5 meter of where the garbage truck can stop (Åmål municipality).
- Place the bin with the pull handle (back) facing outwards.
- Place the waste in a plastic bag instead of putting it into the bin loose.
- Make sure that the road is driveable for the garbage truck, that the width of the road is at least 3.5 meter and there is a free height of at least 4 meter.
- Do not overfill the bin; the lid must be completely closed.
